

What is ORCHESTRA-Cohort?

ORCHESTRA-Cohort is a three-year international research project under the European Union's Horizon 2020 research and innovation programme and has started in December 2020. The main goal is to connect existing cohorts to establish an international large-scale cohort for the conduct of retrospective and prospective studies. We want to generate rigorous evidence to improve the prevention and treatment of COVID-19 and to be better prepared for future pandemics. The project was initiated by Prof. Evelina Tacconelli, is led by the University of Verona and is at the moment involving 26 partners (extending to a wider network of 37 partners) from 15 countries: Argentina, Belgium, Brazil, Congo, France, Gabon, Germany, India, Italy, Luxemburg, Netherlands, Romania, Slovakia, Spain, Venezuela.
